On 20th March 2015, a screening test followed by a seminar was organized for 3rd Year, EC- A and EC- B, at PGI seminar Hall by CDAC, Jaipur (Centre for development of Advance Computing). The seminar was conducted by Dr. Manoj Sharma (Head C-DAC, Jaipur). In seminar Dr. Manoj gave a brief introduction about CDAC in which he told about how CDAC was originated. Supercomputers were first developed in America. When American government denied the demand of supercomputers in India, the two programmers came forward to develop India's own first supercomputer named PARAM 8000.
