#### Introduction

The Department of Management Studies (Poornima School of Management), Poornima Group of Colleges (PGC), besides conducting regular MBA courses, organizes short—term management development/training programs to meet specific needs of the sponsoring organizations. Such programs, being tailor—made, are useful for executives in enhancing their skills in different disciplines.

The institute has organized, so far, 37 programs on topics related to human resource development/management, lending/credit operations, exports, technology up-gradation and retail management.

## **RIICO**

Rajasthan State Industrial Development & Investment Corporation Ltd. (RIICO), a State—owned company, set up in 1969, has been playing a catalytic role in the industrial development of Rajasthan. It has an authorized share capital of Rs. 2350/- million and paid up capital of Rs. 2102/- million. It has emerged as a multi–faceted dynamic institution keeping pace with the industrialization. RIICO is the sole Government agency in the State involved in development of land with supportive infrastructure facilities in the industrial areas. It provides financial and investment support services to large, medium and small scale projects.

RIICO has so far developed 327 industrial areas by acquiring around 74,228 acres of land. Each industrial area is provided with all basic infrastructures like power, water supply, roads and social amenities. RIICO has also embarked upon creation of industry specific areas/special purpose industrial parks/economic zones and integrated infrastructure development and growth center projects.

Other initiatives such as setting up of Center for Development of Stones, development of R&D Center and Stone Testing Laboratory and an Exhibition—cum—Convention Center and organization of industry exhibitions, fairs and seminars focusing on potential areas such as stone industry, ceramics, glass, textile and apparels etc. have helped Rajasthan in being recognized as an attractive investment destination. A number of global players have evinced interest in setting up their ventures.

RIICO has a network of 27 regional offices all over Rajasthan. RIICO has catalyzed investment of more than Rs. 82 billion and generated employment of around 1.08 lakh persons. More than 35 thousand industrial units are in production in industrial areas developed by RIICO.

The financial performance of RIICO has also been impressive. The net profits in the last 3 years (2011-12, 2012-13 and 2013-14), of which audited figures are available, amounted to Rs. 473 crores, Rs. 271 crores and Rs. 133 crores respectively. The variations in profits may be attributed to the nature of the organization's operations.

## **Development of Professional Skills**

The industrial sector has witnessed a series of reforms during the last two decades. The business environment has become more and more competitive. The developmental institutions are also looking at integrating sustainability, environmental issues and social and other risks into project development and financing. RIICO is seized of these developments and is keen to create awareness among its executives and equip them appropriately to meet the emerging challenges.

Development of professional skills has been engaging due attention of the management of RIICO. Training programs are organized from time to time for refreshing/updating the knowledge of the executives at all levels, so that they are made aware of not only the current practices followed for efficient discharge of the various services related to industrial infrastructure development and lending operations but also of new business avenues and strategies in the changing scenario.

#### About the MDP

This two-day management development/training program on managerial skills has been designed for senior and middle level executives of RIICO. The program mainly focuses on Enhancement of HR and Leadership Skills, recognizing the fact that these are essential for development of managerial skills and capabilities.

## **Objectives of the Program**

The objectives of the program are (a) to update/refresh the knowledge of the participants in human resource related areas, (b) to develop managerial skills including professional ethics and human values, (c) to provide opportunity to share experience by close interaction, and (d) to enhance the confidence/capabilities of the participants and make them better equipped to perform their functions with greater efficiency and thus enable them to make their due contribution to the development and growth of the State's economy.

The program will also help the participants in understanding the new concepts of management and latest approaches adopted in dealing with various issues concerned with their day—to—day working. Eminent resource persons, having rich knowledge and experience, have been identified to share their thoughts and experience with the participants in the various technical sessions of the program.
