Report on "VIRTUAL LAB" organized by Dept. of Computer Engineering

The Department of Computer Engineering (PIET) organized an orientation program on "VIRTUAL LAB" at Arbuda Convention Centre on Saturday, 12 Sept' 2015.

The orientation was addressed by team of **IIT Delhi** representatives and sponsored by **MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE AND DEVELOPMENT (MHRD)** under ICT.

The project (VIRTUAL LAB) was an initiative of IIT Delhi in collaboration of other IITs and some renown Universities.
