Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

1. What is REAP-2023?

It is Rajasthan Engineering Admission Process which shall lead to admissions to 1st year of B.E./B.Tech./B.Arch. in Government Aided and Private unaided technical institutions of Rajasthan.

2. Who is eligible to appear for Counseling through REAP-2023? Can Private candidates apply?

The REAP-2023 is open to any candidate who has passed the Class 12 qualifying examination with having eligibility criteria as per AICTE APH 2023-23. Candidates appearing for the Class 12 or equivalent qualifying examination in the year 2023 are also **eligible to apply for REAP-2023**. Candidates who have not appeared in JEE Mains 2023 can also apply, provided they full fill eligibility criteria as per AICTE APH 2023-24 through 12th board percentile.

Private candidates who have passed the Class 12 or equivalent qualifying examination or are appearing for the exam in the year 2023 can apply.

3. Is Diploma candidate eligible to appear for Counseling through REAP-2023?

YES, Diploma candidate can take admission through REAP 2023 in First year.

It is worth noting, Diploma and B.Sc. students can apply through LEEP-2023 for getting admissions in 2nd year of B.E./B.Tech Degree courses.

4. What is the number of permissible attempts to appear for REAP-2023?

Since it is only counseling, therefore question of number of attempts do not arise.

5. How many numbers of counseling rounds to be there in REAP-2023?

REAP-2023 has six rounds of counseling:

6. What is merit and priority in REAP-2023?

Merit and Priority for admission in first year of B.E. / B.Tech is:

REAP-2023 merit will be prepared based on the rank obtained in JEE (Mains) 2023-23 and Percentile/percentage in 12th / Diploma considering the priority as shown below in the table:

S. No	Basis of admissions	Priority
1	Rank obtained in JEE (Mains) 2023	1 st
2	Percentile obtained in class 12 th	2 nd
3	Percentage obtained in Diploma in Engineering & Technology approved by state government.	3 rd

For Candidates having JEE Mains- 2023 Percentile must be greater or equal to 20.

- I. For the applicants applied on the basis of the marks of Class 12th, the percentile (Comparative Score) will be determined on the basis of no. of applicants in REAP-2023 of particular board[#], to obtain combined Rank/ Merit of the candidate.**
- II. In case of, Diploma holders, percentage in diploma will be the criteria for Merit/ Rank.**
- III. In case of tie between the percentiles of candidate's, higher merit would be assigned to a candidate in following pattern: -**
Candidate having higher age will be given higher merit/ rank thereafter the candidate who has applied earlier will be given higher merit/ rank.

#Boards other than RBSE and CBSE will be treated equivalent to CBSE for determining percentile.

7. To take admission what should I do?

Candidates have to click the online application form on the websites and proceed as per guidelines of REAP-2023.

8. What should a candidate do in case of a failed transaction while paying the fee?

In case, the payment status remains as 'Failed' during the online transaction of the application fee, then candidates should note that the fee payment is not complete. In such instances, candidates will be required to pay the fees again via online transaction and download their acknowledgment slip. If the amount is found debited against the previous attempt, the same will be processed at payment gateway and refunded back within 7 to 10 working days.

9. What is the eligibility for private candidates?

The eligibility criteria for REAP-2023 are same for **both regular and private candidates**. It is the same as that of JEE Mains – 2023 eligibility criteria.

Candidates targeting REAP-2023 must have qualified Class XII or equivalent qualifying exam at the time of reporting at the allotted institute. Those who will be appearing in their Class XII exam or equivalent qualifying exam in 2023 are eligible for REAP-2023.

10. How many colleges allow admission through REAP-2023?

11. What are the branches offered by the colleges under REAP-2023?

As per seat matrix available on the website of REAP 2023

12. Is there any management quota in Government Colleges?

No. There is no management quota in Government Colleges.

13. Is there any management quota in Private Colleges?

Yes. There is 15% management quota in Private Colleges.

14. What is the procedure for admission through management quota in Private Colleges?

There are 15% seats reserved in all the branches under management quota in the entire private colleges. A separate merit list according to guidelines of REAP-2023 is prepared for admission under this category. Candidate has to apply separately for the admission under Management Quota at the institute itself.

15. My JEE Mains AIR is XXXXXX. Which seat will I get?

Seat allocation in REAP-2023 is based on JEE Mains-2023 (Paper-I) Rank/ Score and after that based on 12th Board Percentile for B.Tech courses. For admission in B. Arch courses, merit will be prepared on the basis of JEE Mains-2023 (Paper-II) Rank/ Score and after that based on 12th Board Percentile (50% weightage) + NATA score (50% weightage).

16. What is the best strategy of choice filling?

As it is an important moment for the student, so each choice of institute or branch must be filled only after having complete awareness about it. Include only those choices in your list where you are really prepared to go if you get a seat allocated.

Maintaining strict order of preference is also very important. Assume that you really want to take admission in branch XXX in the institute YYY and gave it a choice at no. 12 in your list but you got allotted the choice no. 7. Now you are supposed to take admission in the branch/institute combination at No. 7.

17. What documents will be attested during Counseling?

Candidates shall carry the following documents at the time of reporting to the allotted institute:

1. Printout of provisional seat allotment letter taken from the REAP-2023 web portal using their login details. Candidate should paste their recent color photographs on the **Application cum Registration form** with one additional colored photograph with them.
2. Aadhar Card/ Aadhar Acknowledgement Receipt if available.
3. Class X (High School) Board Marksheet/ Certificate as proof of date of birth.
4. Rank obtained in JEE (Mains) -2023/NATA- 2023
5. Mark sheet of class 12th (for Subjects) or Diploma.

6. Certificate of category (SC / ST/ OBC /MBC/ EWS), issued by the competent authority (if applicable).
7. Undertaking by OBC/MBC in required format (for non-creamy layer), (if applicable).
8. Certificate for Persons with Disabilities (PwD), (if applicable).
9. Certificate for Ex-Service men, (if applicable).
10. Domicile certificate. (if applicable)
11. Income Certificate. (if applicable)
12. Medical Fitness Certificate.
13. Fee to be deposited at the Institute.

Candidates need to deposit requisite fee as decided by the State Level Fee Committee/ Technical Education Department along with self-attested copies of all documents to the reporting institute at the time of reporting. The candidates are advised not to deposit their original documents at the first reported institute at the time of first reporting. However, all the candidates are required to deposit all their original documents at the last/final reporting institute, failing which their admission would be deemed cancelled without any notice/intimation and their seat would be treated as vacant.

The original documents will be returned by the respective College/institute after the enrolment by the concerned University.

18. What original or copies of documents are to be sent along with the application form?

Neither original documents nor any photocopy of documents needs to be sent to REAP-2023 office. But, two sets of photocopies of documents as per the list, given in the Brochure along with the original documents are to be taken to reporting institute.

19. Final Result/Mark sheet of qualifying examination is not available due to delay in declaration of result, is he/she allowed?

All documents in original have to be brought to the reporting centre at the time of reporting in case of seat allocation, failing which the case would be treated as non-reported.

20. If a candidate is appearing in supplementary qualifying examination, is he / she allowed?

Not allowed, one should have clear-cut passed out 12th Examination.

21. Original Mark sheet/document is deposited somewhere else, and a certificate regarding this is available. Can such candidates report to reporting centre after seat allocation?

Student will be allowed to report on the basis of self-attested documents at the time of

admission.

22. I have not received my JEE (Main) 2023 score card. What should I do?

You may download the Score Card from the website for purpose of presenting at the reporting centre at the time of reporting.

23. Is Reservation is applicable for category student?

The seats available for admission would be notified separately on web portal. However the reservation of seats as prescribed by the Government of Rajasthan and order No. [एफ 1\(6\)त.सि./2021](#) ,dated 03 Feb, 2021 received from Secretary department of technical education, the reservation on all types of seats (self-financed and Govt. aided seats) in Autonomous Engineering Colleges of Government of Rajasthan/Constituent College of Government Universities, Government Universities and Private Technical Institutes (Except Management Quota) will be made subject to the prevalent statutory provisions of the State of Rajasthan viz. 16% for SC candidates, 12% for ST candidates, 21% for candidates belonging to non-creamy layer OBC category¹, 10% for Economical weaker section (EWS) candidates² and 5% for candidates belonging to non-creamy layer MBC category³.

1. As per the state government department of personnel notification no. F7 (8) DOP/A-2/2008 dated 19.02.2019, the limit of non-creamy layer has been raised and substituted as "rupees eight lakh".

2. As per the state government department of personnel notification no.F.7 (1) DOP/A-II/2019 dated 22.02.2019.

3. As per the state government order by DOP dated 08/03/2019.

As per the state government order no. F1(6)/Tech.Edu. /1999 Jaipur Dated 04-07-2016, the 45% seats of prescribed 12% ST quota will be reserved for TSP in all institute where ST reservation is available. The candidates who belong to notified TSP areas and come under ST reservation will be eligible under this quota.

Provision will also be made for horizontal reservation of:

5% for candidates belonging to person with

special ability (PwD)25% for women in their

respective reservation category and

3% for dependents of Ex-servicemen category.(50% of the reserved seats in this category are earmarked for the girls)

Priority of the defense person/Ex-Servicemen is as follows:

Code	Category
EXS1	Widows/ wards of killed in action.
EXS2	Wards of Disabled in action and boarded out from service.
EXS3	Widows/ Wards of Defence personnel who died while in service with death attributable to Military service.
EXS4	Wards of disabled in service and boarded out with disability attributable to military service.

EXS5	Wards of Ex-Servicemen and serving personnel who are in receipt of Gallantry Awards. i) Paramvir Chakra ii) Ashok Chakra iii) MahaVir Chakra iv) Kirti Chakra v)Vir Chakra
EXS6	Wards of Ex-Servicemen.
EXS7	Wives of defence personnel i) Disabled in action and boarded out from service. ii) Disabled in service and boarded out with disability attributable to military service. iii) Ex-Servicemen and Serving personnel who are in receipt of Gallantry Awards.
EXS8	Wards of Serving Personnel.
EXS9	Wives of Serving Personnel.

24. As per REAP-2023 record, category is OPEN. Can the category be changed from OPEN to SC/ST/OBC?

No, it cannot be changed.

25. Is category change possible during online registration?

Change of Category is possible at the time of online registration before the candidate presses “Submit” button, but change of category from afterwards is not allowed.

.If the candidate fails to submit category certificate or category given by the candidate is found to be wrong at the time of verification of certificates and also at the time of reporting, his / her provisional allocation of the seat shall automatically stand cancelled. However, the candidate will be allowed for the next rounds of seat allocation for the available vacant seats only, after obtaining an undertaking from the candidate and updating his/her category based on the original certificates.

26. Is there any reservation for sub-category?

Reservation for sub-category is only for Persons with Disabilities (PwD), Ex-servicemen and Kashmiri Migrants, at present.

27. Who is eligible for persons with disabilities category?

To be eligible for consideration under persons with disabilities category, a candidate must have a minimum of 40% disability (declared by a competent medical board) subject to the condition that the candidate is capable of carrying out all activities related to theory and practical work as applicable to B.E. / B.Tech / B. Arch Courses.

28. What happens if I do not register during specified period?

Such candidates cannot fill in choices and hence are out of the admission process of REAP 2023 (the first Five rounds). However they can register for the special round.

29. If a candidate forgets his/her password, how to get a new password?

Whenever a candidate forgets his/her password, he/she has to use the “Forgot Password” link. Candidate would be asked some additional information given by him/her at the time of online registration and then the password would be forwarded to the registered email ID and mobile number of the candidate.

30. Can the name of the candidate be changed during seat allocation?

No change in name is permitted.

31. How many choices can a candidate give?

A candidate can submit as many numbers of choices in order of preference as he/she wishes from the list of his/her available choices. It is advised to fill maximum number of choices so that choice exhaust situation does not arise.

32. What is locking?

Locking is the process of final submission of choices.

33. If a candidate doesn't lock his/her choices, will they be processed for seat allocation?

It is in the interest of the candidates that they lock their choices themselves before the deadline. However, in cases where candidates fail to lock their choices, the last saved choices will be locked automatically after the last day of choice filling.

34. Can the candidate modify the choices after locking?

After locking the choices, the candidate cannot modify his/her choices.

35. Is it required to pay any fee at the time of choice filling?

NO, it is not required to pay any fee during choice filling; only registration fee is required at the time of REAP registration.

36. I belongs to Rajasthan, how could I apply for admission?

The candidates of Rajasthan are admitted through REAP-2023. For admission, you have to participate in REAP-2023 counseling.

37. I belongs to outside Rajasthan, how could I apply for admission?

The candidates from outside Rajasthan are admitted on behalf of their JEE Mains-2023 rank/Score or Class-12th marks/percentile through counseling conducted by REAP-2023.

38. Bank Loan?

Almost all nationalize banks provide loan facility to eligible student. Students are advised to contact to their nearest bank/branch for this purpose.

39. Scholarship?

AICTE has a Tuition Fee waiver scheme in various government and private engg. Colleges. Apart from these, assistantship for scholarship through various government departments and Other Organizations may also be availed.

40. Too whom I should contact for problems related to admissions in REAP2023?

Candidates are advised to communicate on email ID reap22studenthelp@gmail.com. While communicating through email, do not forget to mention your name, Application number, and mobilenumbr. Kindly be precise andstraight forward in mentioning your problem and type of assistance required.

41. When I am supposed to get refund in case of non-admission or timely withdrawal from admission process?

Refund for all such cases will be done as per norms, after the completion of REAP-2023 Counseling process.
